Background

- •The Maritime and Aquaculture High School is located in Etel since 1941
- •It has adapted to the different political reforms and keeps its maritime identity despite the "gales".
- •Some work in 1999 allowed us to welcome more students, including 8 young women out of 200 students
- •Regional investments into technical facilities
- •But also, new educational investment with the reform of the professional training.

- .17 young women this year (0, 1 or 2 per class)
- •92% of the students come from our area (Brittany + 44)



Our Goals

- -Strengthen the role of women in fisheries
