Selection process of the fisheries local action groups (Finland)

Starting point in Finland in 2020

In 2020 the situation in Finland was as follows:

- High level of commitments of EMFF funding, but no possibilities to finance the transitional period for fisheries local action groups (FLAGs).
- Start of the programme period 2021-2027 to be postponed by at least one year.

In order to ensure continuation of Community Led Local Development work without interruption, the selection process

New features for Community Led Local Development in Finland (2021-2027)

In 2020 the situation in Finland was as follows:

- A flat rate model to cover FLAGs operational costs
- A National network formed by FLAGs. The objective of the network is to support implementation of the national EMFAF programme with a specific focus on the national and international cooperation of the FLAGs, communication activities and dissemination of information as well as the cooperation and synergies of the local and national development work.
